



## Butterfly Magnet

**IMAGINE Craft Supplies** Goosebumps Clear Texture Spray, Ink Potion No. 9, Clear Embossing Powder  
**Tsukineko Supplies** VersaMark and Memento Elderberry full-size inkpads; Memento markers: Morocco, Love Letter, Elderberry, Peanut Brittle, Teal Zeal, Nautical Blue, Tuxedo Black  
**Rubber Stamp** Penny Black "Soft Wings" #40-099  
**Other Supplies** Magnetic Snaps (Basic Gray), Canson Watercolor Paper 140 lb. Cold Press, paintbrush, heat tool.

**Step 1** Apply VersaMark ink to the stamp. Before making the impression, apply Elderberry Memento ink directly to the stamp over the previously applied ink. This will allow for heat embossing dye ink.

**Step 2** Stamp the butterfly onto watercolor paper. Sprinkle clear embossing powder over image; tap off excess. Heat set with heat tool.

**Step 3** Color the image with Memento markers using a combination of direct-to-paper and plastic palette techniques.

**Step 4** Trim images with scissors. Edge the sides and color the back of the image with Tuxedo Black Memento marker.

**Step 5** Pour a small amount of Goosebumps into a shallow dish. Using a paintbrush, "glaze" the butterfly with the Goosebumps to create a varnish-like finish. Allow to dry.

**Step 6** Attach magnet to back of butterfly.
