



What is Vertigo?

Vertigo is a sturdy, transluscent material that reflects and refracts light, creating dazzling visual effects. Vertigo is available in 6 patterns that evoke swirls, bubbles, lines or ripples -- a whirl of depth and motion.

What can you do with Vertigo?

- Stamp or color with StazOn $^{\otimes}$, Memento Luxe[™] and other pigment inks
- Cut with paper trimmer or scissors, or use with a hole punch
- Create die-cut embellishments and emboss with most die-cut/ embossing machines
- Apply embossing powders for color and texture
- Apply over images and other artwork to create dimensional layers
- Score and fold for 3-D crafts
- Create dimensional shapes by warping with a heat gun

• card embellishments • book covers • lamp shades • gift card holders • mobiles • ornaments • jewelry • and more!

Tips on using Vertigo

- Heat set to speed up ink drying time (heat carefully to prevent warping)
- Use with spray adhesives or clear liquid glue to maintain a transparent look
- Vertigo has a shiny and a matte side. For best results, color on the matte side and stamp on the shiny side
