

Vertigo Triptych Card

Supplies

From IMAGINE Crafts/Tsukineko

- Memento Luxe in Tuxedo Black, Bahama Blue, Wedding White, Dandelion and Pear Tart
- InkBlushers
- StazOn Solvent Inks in Jet Black and Cactus Green
- Vertigo in Taffeta

Other: Memory Box "Umbels" stamp, a | muse studio "thinking of you" stamp, yellow and white cardstock



Directions

- Cut out a 4" x 6" rectangle from the Vertigo.
 Cut a scrap of Vertigo in a flag shape approx.
 2" x .5".
- 2. Using InkBlushers and Memento Luxe, shade one side of the Vertigo in a sweeping motion while alternating colors: Bahama Blue, Dandelion and Pear Tart diagonally. Blend with Wedding White to lighten colors as desired. Heat set carefully keeping the heat gun at a distance.
- 3. Stamp Umbels 3-4 times on each side using Memento Luxe in Tuxedo Black. Carefully heat set, then stamp sentiment on the flag piece and edge with Cactus Green StazOn.
- 4. Cut Vertigo into 3 equal rectangles, each 4" x 2".
- 5. Adhere each rectangle to the same sized pieces of white cardstock.
- 6. Adhere panels to cardstock, evenly spaced, with dimensional tape. Add flag with sentiment to the right side.
